1 Purpose of Report

To present proposed increases in charges made for special services.

2 Recommendations

The Fire Authority is asked to approve that the proposed charges for special services be applied from 1 April 2008.

3 Background

Charging for special services is currently permitted by Orders issued under Section 19 of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004. This report lays out proposed increases to the current tariff of charges, following a review undertaken at the request of the Fire Authority.

4 The Fire Authority's Current Charges

The tariff of charges currently in place for special services is reviewed annually. Following approval of the last increases in February 2007, Members of the Fire Authority requested that a full review was undertaken.

Finance officers collated tariffs from fire services both around the country and regionally, and Shropshire's charges were measured against them. Following the review, officers concluded that this Authority's tariff was not out of line with what was being charged regionally and nationally. The review also drew the attention of Members to the small monetary values earned from special service calls.

To this end, it is proposed that the Authority's charges are increased for inflationary purposes only, and that the percentage rate to be used is the pay award for operational staff, awarded in July 2007.



5 Financial Implications

There are no financial implications arising directly from this report other than those discussed within the report

6 Legal Comment

The Fire Authority has the power to impose special charges only in certain circumstances.

7 Equality Impact Assessment

Officers have considered the Service's Brigade Order on Equality Impact Assessments (Personnel 5 Part 2) and have decided that there are no discriminatory practices or differential impacts upon specific groups arising from this report. An Initial Equality Impact Assessment has not, therefore, been completed.
